

LEVITICUS 11

2 TIMOTHY 3:16

- "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness"

LEVITICUS 11:1-8

- And the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying to them, "Speak to the people of Israel, saying, These are the living things that you may eat among all the animals that are on the earth. Whatever parts the hoof and is cloven-footed and chews the cud, among the animals, you may eat. Nevertheless, among those that chew the cud or part the hoof, you shall not eat these: The camel, because it chews the cud but does not part the hoof, is unclean to you. And the rock badger, because it chews the cud but does not part the hoof, is unclean to you. And the hare, because it chews the cud but does not part the hoof, is unclean to you. And the pig, because it parts the hoof and is cloven-footed but does not chew the cud, is unclean to you. You shall not eat any of their flesh, and you shall not touch their carcasses; they are unclean to you.

LEVITICUS 11:9-12

- "These you may eat, of all that are in the waters. Everything in the waters that has fins and scales, whether in the seas or in the rivers, you may eat. But anything in the seas or the rivers that does not have fins and scales, of the swarming creatures in the waters and of the living creatures that are in the waters, is detestable to you. You shall regard them as detestable; you shall not eat any of their flesh, and you shall detest their carcasses. Everything in the waters that does not have fins and scales is detestable to you.

LEVITICUS 11:13-19

- “And these you shall detest among the birds; they shall not be eaten; they are detestable: the eagle, the bearded vulture, the black vulture, the kite, the falcon of any kind, every raven of any kind, the ostrich, the nighthawk, the sea gull, the hawk of any kind, the little owl, the cormorant, the short-eared owl, the barn owl, the tawny owl, the carrion vulture, the stork, the heron of any kind, the hoopoe, and the bat.

LEVITICUS 11:24-28

- “And by these you shall become unclean. Whoever touches their carcass shall be unclean until the evening, and whoever carries any part of their carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until the evening. Every animal that parts the hoof but is not cloven-footed or does not chew the cud is unclean to you. Everyone who touches them shall be unclean. And all that walk on their paws, among the animals that go on all fours, are unclean to you. Whoever touches their carcass shall be unclean until the evening, and he who carries their carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until the evening; they are unclean to you.

WAS THIS FOR HEALTH BENEFITS?

1. The Bible does not give this purpose.
2. Israel had been functioning well for hundreds of years.

EXODUS 1:9-10

- And he said to his people, "Behold, the people of Israel are too many and too mighty for us. Come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and, if war breaks out, they join our enemies and fight against us and escape from the land."

WAS THIS FOR HEALTH BENEFITS?

1. The Bible does not give this purpose.
2. Israel had been functioning well for hundreds of years.
3. There's no evidence in scripture or secular history that this had a great effect on Israel's health.
4. It's inconsistent.
5. Faith in Jesus eliminated those laws.

WHAT IS THE REAL REASON WHY?

LEVITICUS 11:41-45

- "Every swarming thing that swarms on the ground is detestable; it shall not be eaten. Whatever goes on its belly, and whatever goes on all fours, or whatever has many feet, any swarming thing that swarms on the ground, you shall not eat, for they are detestable. You shall not make yourselves detestable with any swarming thing that swarms, and you shall not defile yourselves with them, and become unclean through them. For I am the Lord your God. WHAT IS THE REAL REASON WHY?

LEVITICUS 11:41-45

- "Every swarming thing that swarms on the ground is detestable; it shall not be eaten. YOU SHALL BE HOLY

- Because I am the Lord your God.
- Because I am holy, so be like me.

CONSECRATED AND HOLY

- Consecrate - make or declare something sacred; dedicate formally to a religious or divine purpose.
- Holy - Set apart for God's purposes

HOW DO THESE LIMITATIONS CONSECRATE ISRAEL AND MAKE HER HOLY?

- They created a culture distinct and different from others
- Israel practiced making distinctions between holy and common things
- It showed them that the things that you come in contact with and consume have consequences

LEVITICUS 11:29-31

- “And these are unclean to you among the swarming things that swarm on the ground: the mole rat, the mouse, the great lizard of any kind, the gecko, the monitor lizard, the lizard, the sand lizard, and the chameleon. These are unclean to you among all that swarm. **Whoever touches them when they are dead shall be unclean until the evening.**

**HOW IS THIS PROFITABLE TO US
TODAY?**

WE'RE CALLED TO BE DIFFERENT

MATTHEW 5:13-16

- "You are the **salt of the earth**, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. You are the light of the world. **A city set on a hill** cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, **let your light shine** before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

1ST CORINTHIANS 5:1-13

- For though absent in body, I am present in spirit; and as if present, I have already pronounced judgment on the one who did such a thing. When you are assembled in the name of the Lord Jesus and my spirit is present, with the power of our Lord Jesus, you are to deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord.

THE THINGS THAT YOU CONSUME AND COME IN CONTACT WITH HAVE CONSEQUENCES

1ST CORINTHIANS 5:1-13

- Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people— not at all meaning the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world. But now I am writing to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of brother if he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler—not even to eat with such a one. For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Is it not those inside the church whom you are to judge? God judges those outside. “Purge the evil person from among you.”
