 - ◆ What question did Jesus ask? Why?

 - ◆ Of what did Jesus warn the crowd?
 - ◆ Compare Matthew 23:1-7.
 - ◆ What was the lesson of the widow?

Mark 13:1-37

- ◆ Jesus warnings (Matthew 24, Luke 21:5-36)
 - ◆ What event does Jesus describe here? Consider:
 - ◆ Specific description - v. 2
 - ◆ Signs: claims of false messiahs - v. 5-6, 21-23
 - ◆ Signs: political and military unrest -v. 7-8
 - ◆ Signs: natural catastrophes - v. 8
 - ◆ Signs: persecution - v. 9-13, 19
 - ◆ Signs: the abomination of desolation - v. 14

- ◆ Jesus warnings (Matthew 24, Luke 21:5-36)
 - ◆ What event does Jesus describe here? Cont.
 - ◆ What reactions are described? Why - v. 14-18
 - ◆ What is the significance of v. 23?
 - ◆ Consider the following OT passages:
 - ◆ Isaiah 13:10, Joel 2:10, 28-32
 - ◆ Daniel 7:13, Deuteronomy 30:4
 - ◆ What image does Jesus intend to deliver?
