## Mark 13:1-37

- Jesus warnings (Matthew 24, Luke 21:5-36)
  - What event does Jesus describe here? Consider:
    - Specific description v. 2
    - Signs: claims of false messiahs v. 5-6, 21-23
    - Signs: political and military unrest -v. 7-8
    - Signs: natural catastrophes v. 8
    - Signs: persecution v. 9-13, 19
    - Signs: the abomination of desolation v. 14

  - What event does Jesus describe here? Cont.
    - What reactions are described? Why v. 14-18
    - What is the significance of v. 23?
    - Consider the following OT passages:
      - Isaiah 13:10, Joel 2:10, <u>28-32</u>
      - Daniel 7:13, Deuteronomy 30:4
      - What image does Jesus intend to deliver?
