 - Signs: natural catastrophes v. 8
 - Signs: persecution and preaching v. 9-13, 19
 - Signs: the abomination of desolation v. 14

 - What image does Jesus intend to deliver?

 - How did Judas react?

- Jesus warnings (Matthew 26:17-25, Luke 22:1-23, John 13:1-30)
 - Jesus' last passover (cf. Deuteronomy 16)
 - What instructions does Jesus give the disciples?
 - Where did they prepare and eat the passover?
 - What did Jesus reveal to them?
 - How did they react?
