





- 1. The Salvation of Jonah (Jonah 1-2)
 - Jonah rejects the will of the Lord and is punished
 (1)
 - Jonah repents and is saved (2)
- 2. The Salvation of Nineveh (Jonah 3-4)
 - Nineveh repents for rejecting the will of the Lord and is saved (3)
 - Jonah learns a lesson about compassion (4)

SPENDING TIME
WITH THE PROPHETS the book of Jonah

- 1. The Lord is God of the nations
- 2. The Lord is a God who saves the repentant
- 3. Man is to mold his conduct to conform to God's will
