

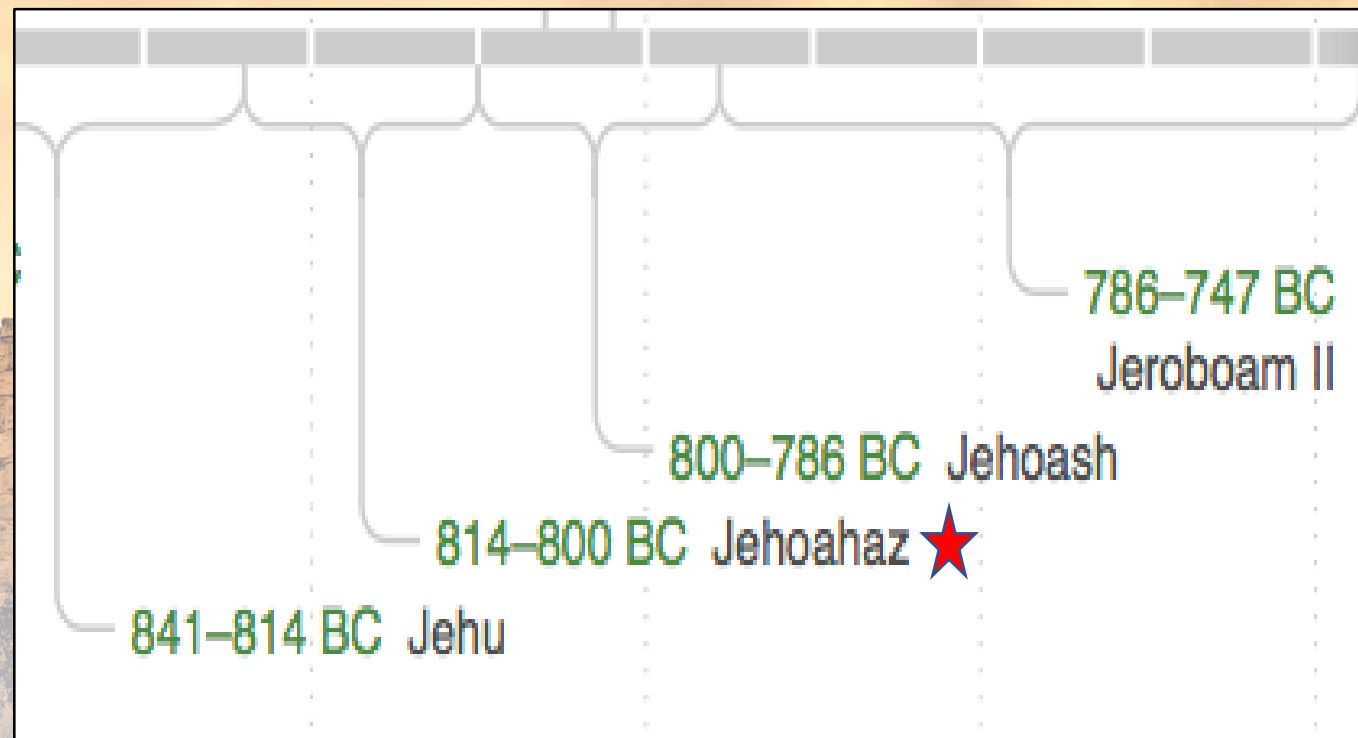

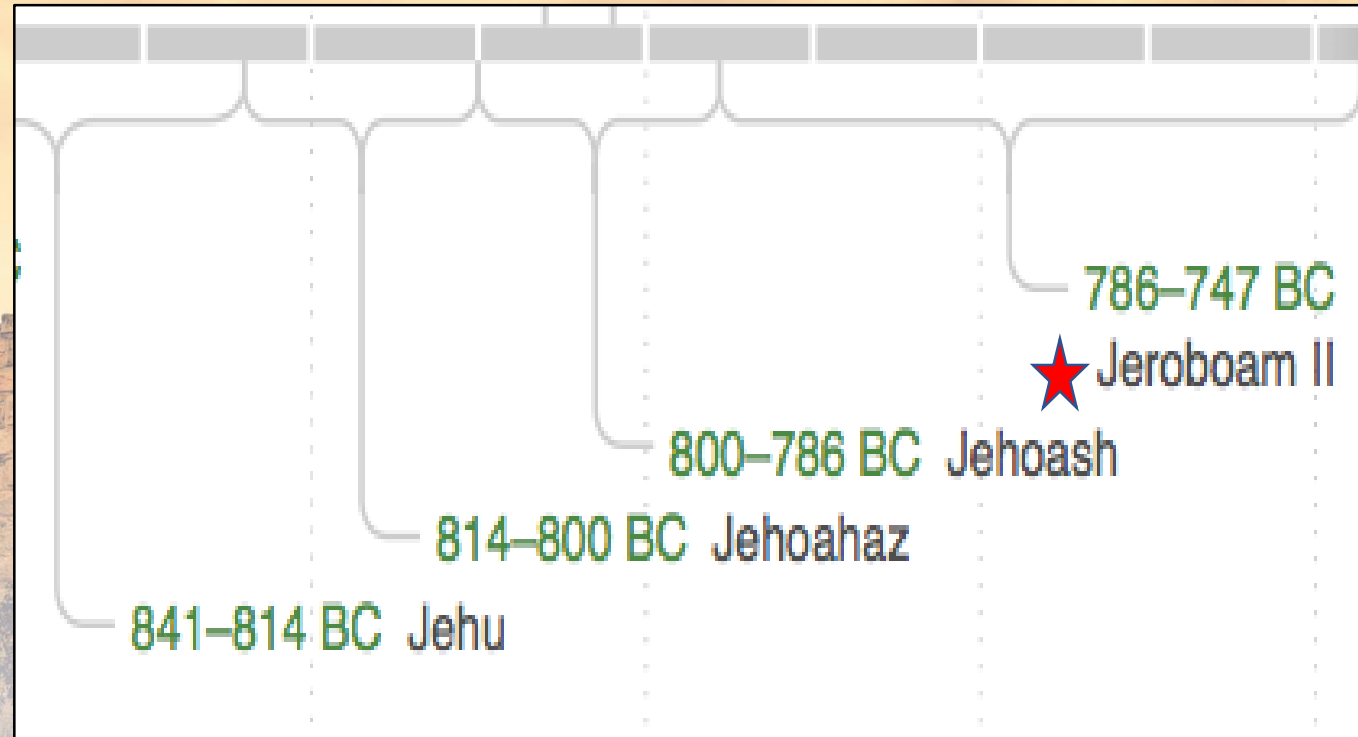


Mediterranean Sea

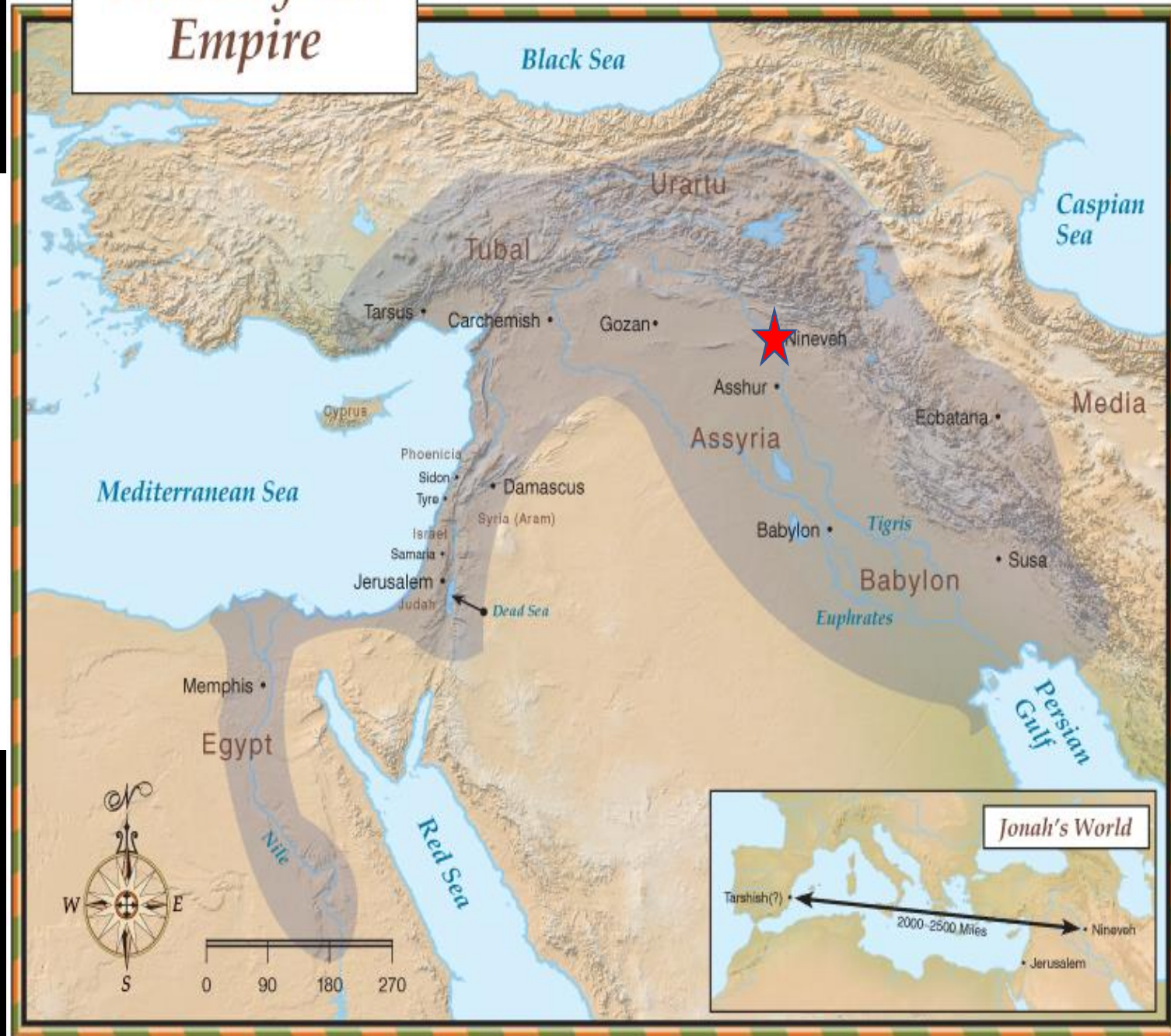







The Assyrian Empire

- 1. The Salvation of Jonah (Jonah 1-2)**
- **Jonah rejects the will of the Lord and is punished (1)**
 - **Jonah repents and is saved (2)**
- 2. The Salvation of Nineveh (Jonah 3-4)**
- **Nineveh repents for rejecting the will of the Lord and is saved (3)**
 - **Jonah learns a lesson about compassion (4)**
