

### Lesson 6: I Did It My Way!

1. According to Peter how can a disobedient husband be won (**I Peter 3:1-2**)?
2. True story . . . He was married to a Christian and tried every way he could to discourage her from attending the assembly on Sunday. He would purposefully go out drinking Saturday nights so that she would have to drive him home and . . . be out so late that she would be unable to get up on Sunday mornings. It didn't work. By the time he stirred, she was gone to worship. Initially, he decided to show up and peek in the window of the church building. Eventually he came late and stood (unknown to her) in the foyer. He was taken with the singing and convicted by the Word. Finally, one Sunday he came on his own and, to her surprise, took his place in the pew beside her. Soon thereafter, my friend walked down the aisle, confessed Jesus as the Son of God, and was baptized into Christ. To this day he will tell you tearfully that it was her quiet and godly demeanor that won him over. She died a few years back and yet he lives each day in the hope of heaven because of a woman that decided to do it "God's way." Discuss and be prepared to share any similar stories you have.
